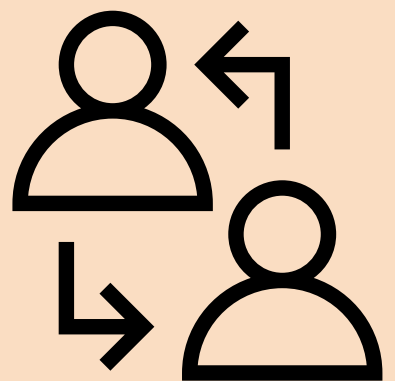
BRING SOCIAL STUDIES TO LIFE



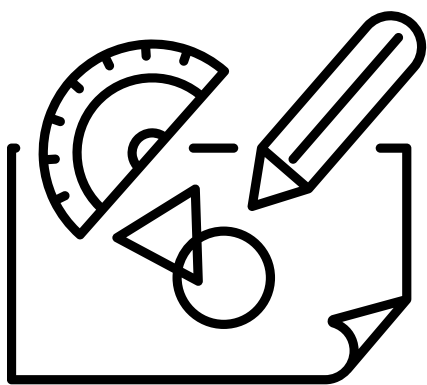
- Connect students to the past and the world around them by using primary sources, untold narratives, and historical fiction.

- Be personable and allow yourself to have fun!



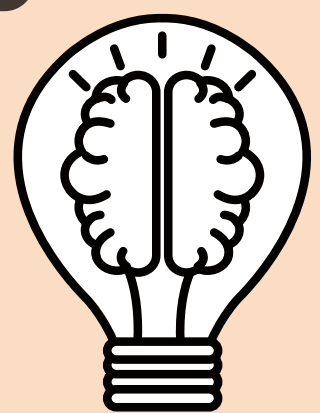
IGNITE PASSION THROUGH PROJECT-BASED LEARNING



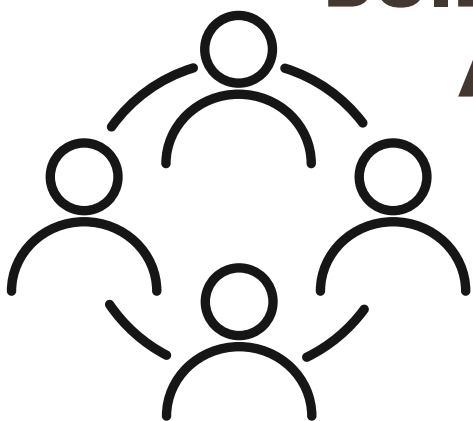
- Make connections to real world scenarios
